Technical Information

Fixing Instructions

Silktrim MDF mouldings are easy to fix using traditional tools and materials.

Silktrim mouldings may be fixed in a similar manner to Softwood mouldings, although there is no need to allow for shrinkages, or to cross-nail mitred joints. Before being fixed in place, ends that are cut or notched on site should be re-sealed using primer/sealer or varnish.

Conditioning

It is recommended that Silktrim mouldings are allowed to remain in the area of fixing for approximately 24 hours before use.

Nailing

'Lost-head' nails are recommended, as these will reduce the need for filling and therefore reduce finishing time. These should be spaced at 600mm centres.

Screw Fixing

Silktrim can be fixed using screws and wallplugs, although it is recommended that parallel threaded screws, threaded to the head of the screw in pre-drilled pilot holes be used.

Filling

Any fixing holes should be filled using nitrocellulose or a good quality non-water based filler.

Storage

Although mini-packs are supplied spiral-wrapped, we advise that you store Silktrim in dry conditions.
